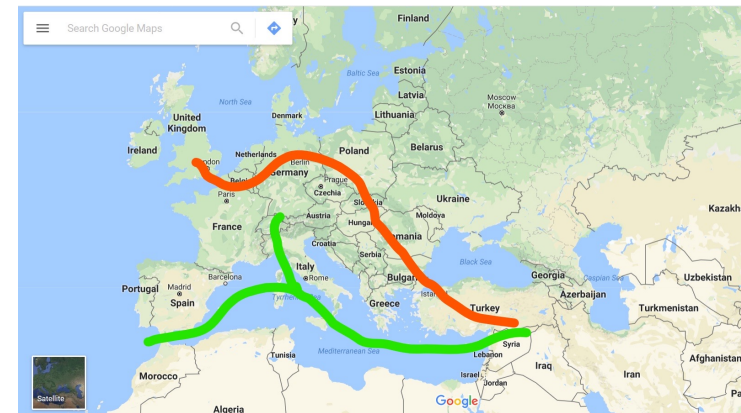

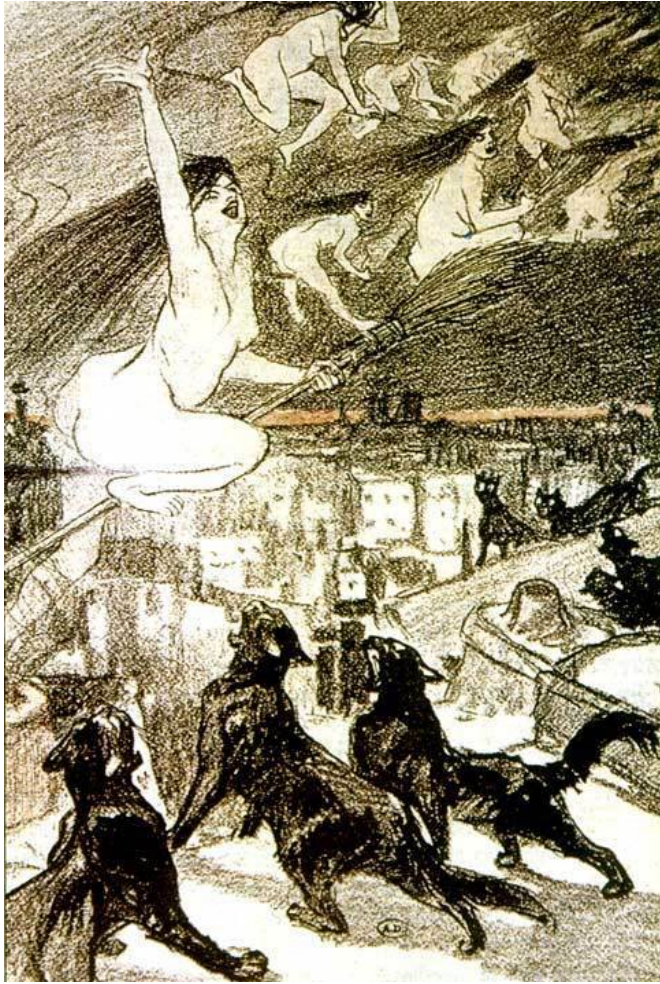

was created in Lyon in **1761**



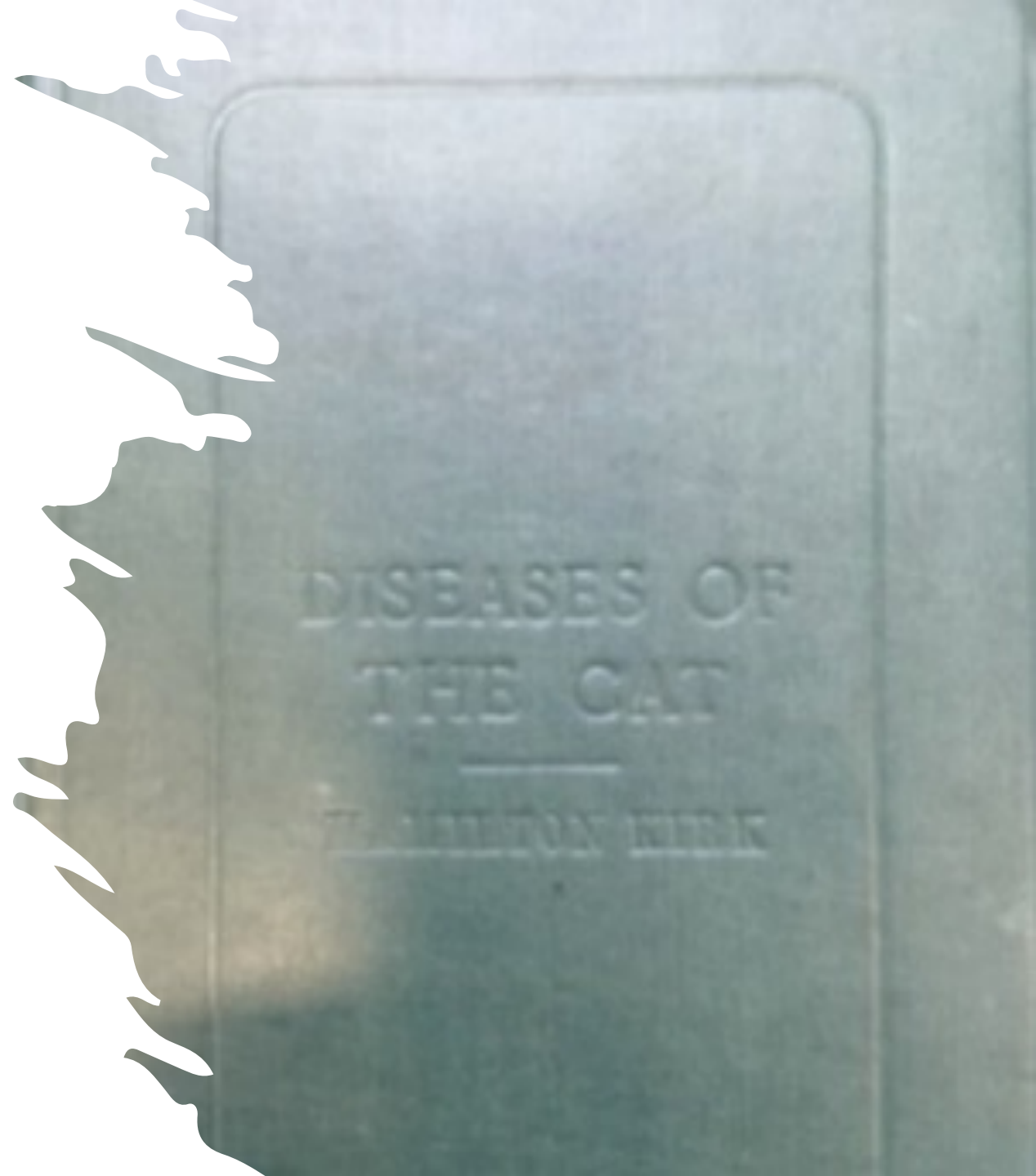

- Caballos (R.U.) Caballos y vacas (EU, USA)

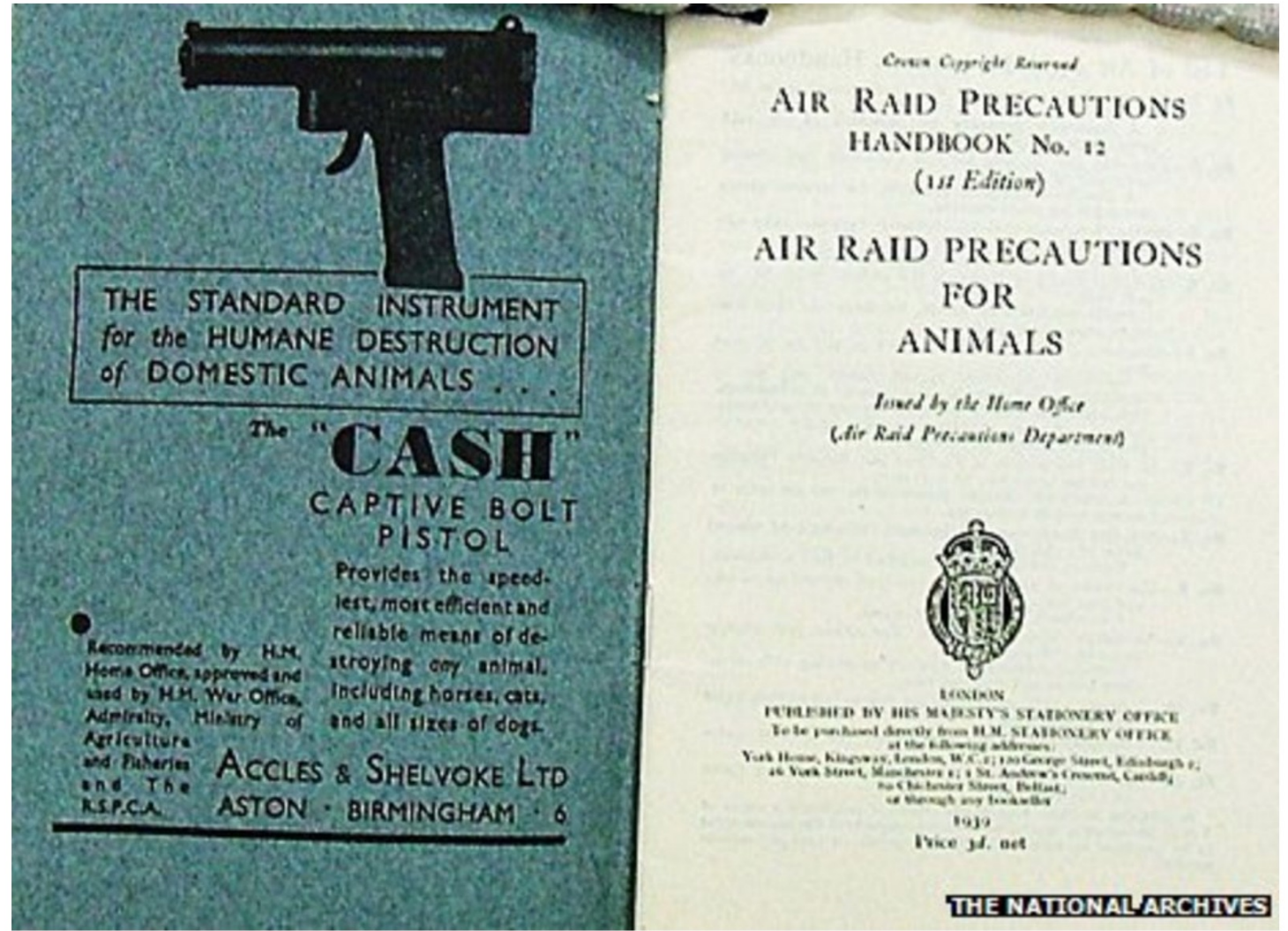
Antes y durante la década de los 20

- Arsénico, extractos de plantas, metales pesados
- Vivisecciones
- (Cloroformo, cocaína)



Los años 30 & 40

- Trivalente (panleukopenia y rinotraqueitis): aislamiento en 1928
- Aislamiento por separado (FPV, FCV, FHV) en 1932
- 1939: Difteria
- Toxoplasmosis y tuberculosis: zoonosis
- Úlceras indolentes, cristaluria
- Guerra: eutanasia humanitaria
- 1947- Arena en EE.UU
